Manuscripts submitted for publication should be typewritten (preferred font is 12-pt. Times New Roman if word-processed) double-spaced throughout, with wide margins on standard-size bond paper. Notes and Reference Lists, also double-spaced, should appear on separate sheets at the end of the manuscript. The manuscript should have a maximum of 40 pages. Please send two copies of the manuscript, one for a blind-review process, with the author's name appearing only on an attached letter giving title, affiliation, and complete address. Send an additional copy, also prepared for blind-review, as an email attachment to the Editor. Contributors should keep copies of all materials submitted. Articles with source citations and reference lists in the wrong format will be returned for correction. *Synergeia* subscribes to the APA 5th ed. for the Social Sciences, Education, Psychology, and Philosophy; MLA 6th ed. for Literature, Arts and Theology; and CMS 15th ed. for History.
